

Accident, Incident and occupational disease training workshop

Overview

In every day life it is inevitable that someone under your control may have an accident or be involved in an incident where they need quick, decisive and efficient help to ensure their health and welfare.

This course is aimed at providing a straight forward overview of Regulations associated with accident and incident management, including how to deal with and report accidents, incidents and occupational diseases.

Course duration

The training workshop is of half a day duration (3.5 hours).

Depending on client preferences, the course will start at either 09.30am (09.00 registration) or 1.30pm (1.00pm registration) and finish at 1.00pm or 5.00 pm respectively.

What will the training workshop cover?

The training workshop will cover the following key attributes and control measures:

- RIDDOR Regulations – an overview of the Regulations and how to apply them
- How to quickly and effectively deal with an accident, an incident, a dangerous occurrence or a reported occupational disease
- Effective accident investigation and interview techniques
- Confidentiality
- Effective reporting and report writing
- Effective follow up and review of corrective actions to provide value-added preventive solutions
- First aid support
- Training, awareness and competence – minimum requirements for those carrying out accident management activities and support activities such as fire marshalling and first aid

Certification

All candidates will be required to complete a simple, straightforward written examination to verify that they have fully understood the scope and content of this training workshop.

On completion of the training workshop, all successful candidates will receive a certification of attendance.
