

## Risk assessment training workshop

### Overview

One corner stone of the Health and Safety in the Workplace Regulations is ensuring a suitably robust risk assessment is carried out to support all hazardous activities in the workplace.

Depending on the nature, scope, complexity and duration of a work activity, this can be a few words, or if particularly complex may require many words and cross-reference to other key health and safety information.

This course is aimed at providing a straight forward overview of the Regulations and how to carry out suitable and sufficient activity-based risk assessments

### Course duration

The training workshop is of half a day duration (3.5 hours).

### What will the training workshop cover?

- Understanding the difference between objective evidence and subjective comment
- Creating an exemplar risk assessment
- Communication and review of risk assessments
